This traineeship will give support to the ongoing assessment of country-scale resource efficiency indicators, developed in the context of a project called Life cycle based indicators. Data on emission in air, soil and water as well of resource use at EU and global level will be used as basis for calculating potential impacts for 15 impact categories (including climate change, ozone depletion, human toxicity and ecotoxicity, land use, resource depletion etc). The interpretation of the results will be the basis for developing baseline scenarios for policy support.
